



Solicitor: Bear Creek sewer plan nearing completion

The fight to prevent sewers dictated by the state Department of Environmental Protection is continuing, Solicitor William Vinsko told Bear Creek Township residents during Monday's supervisors meeting.

The township's ACT 537 Plan, which dictates sewage enforcement, is nearing completion, Vinsko said. No meeting has been set between DEP and the township to formally discuss the application, he said.

Some issues with the ACT 537 might be resolved with a pending well project by Aqua American Pennsylvania Water, Vinsko said.

"I just want to make sure we don't have any lingering water issues," he said. "I want it all resolved when we turn in our (ACT 537)."
