



## WHAT TO DO IF YOU'RE IN A CAR ACCIDENT

**STOP YOUR VEHICLE** In the case that no one is injured and there is little damage, simply exchange with the other driver: Names, Addresses, Phone numbers, Names of your insurance companies, Insurance policy numbers, Driver's license numbers, License plate numbers, Car Make, Model, Year

**CALL THE POLICE** In the case of serious injury, fatality or extensive damage to either or both vehicles, you must call the police who will file an accident report. Don't sign any insurance forms related to an accident-related injury without first consulting an attorney.

**IF YOU'RE OFFERED MEDICAL TREATMENT, TAKE IT.**

**AFTER THE POLICE ARRIVE** When the police arrive, answer the officer's questions. Get names and numbers of witnesses. If possible, after the accident and scene has been cleared, take photos and notes about the accident – weather, street conditions and other pertinent information can be useful information if you're sued.
